DIRECTIONS

For HVAC professional use only.

Place the tablet away from the drain outlet, anywhere between the coil and the drain outlet. It is important only that the tablet comes into contact with the moving water. The tablet will completely dissolve, coating all the drains. The tablet does not have to remain visible, the coating protects the drains, preventing microbial attachment.

DANGER

Contains: Quaternary ammonium compounds, C12-14- alkyl(ethylphenyl)methyl dimethyl, chlorides; Quaternary ammonium compounds, benzyl-C12-18-alkyldimethyl, chlorides.
